¿Qué es el SAT?

El SAT I Reasoning Test, es un examen que muestra las habilidades en inglés de dominio del idioma y razonamiento matemático de un estudiante.

Es en su totalidad de opción múltiple y tiene duración de 3 horas.

El SAT I consiste en dos partes, más un apartado opcional de *Essay* (ensayo):

1. Matemáticas,
2. Prueba basada en Escritura y Lectura

¿Para qué debo tomar el SAT?

La mayoría de las universidades estadounidenses solicitan este examen para que seas admitido(a). Hay que tener en cuenta que cuán mayor sea el prestigio académico y deportivo de la Universidad, mayor puntaje SAT va a requerir, es decir, el resultado en este examen define el tipo de universidad que podrás atender: Entre mayor resultado obtengas, más oportunidades universitarias y tipos de becas conseguirás.

Es muy importante entender que muchos estudiantes-atletas desean estudiar en universidades como Harvard, Yale, Stanford u otras como éstas. Sin embargo, son pocos los que llegan a tener la puntuación para lograrlo. Para darte una idea, Stanford no considerará un aspirante si no obtiene un mínimo de 1,500 puntos (SAT actual). E incluso, puede además recomendar tomar el SAT Subject Test, dependiendo de la carrera que desees estudiar.

¿Qué puntaje debo obtener?

El máximo puntaje posible en el SAT actual son 1,600 puntos para poder competir en la mayoría de las universidades de 4 años. Un puntaje considerado como aprobatorio sería de 1,200. Obtener un resultado de 1,500 o mayor, podría abrirte las puertas a casi cualquier universidad del país.



IMPORTANT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- By registering for the SAT, you're certifying that you are the person whose personal information is being provided for this registration and that the information you are providing about yourself is accurate. If at the time of registration you give false or misleading information about yourself, such as name, address, date of birth, current grade level, expected graduation date, name of high school, or photo, such misrepresentation can result in a score validity investigation and cancellation of scores.
- If your school participates in an SAT School Day administration and/or bulk registration process for the test, the College Board may receive your personal information, including first name, last name, sex, date of birth, and mailing address, from your school. This information will be kept secure and added to your permanent College Board record to be used for score reporting purposes as well as the other purposes outlined in The SAT and SAT Subject Tests™ Registration Booklet and registration materials. By taking the SAT and signing the SAT answer sheet, you acknowledge that your school has provided this information to the College Board and consent to the College Board retaining this information.
- Creating multiple College Board student accounts, intentionally or inadvertently, is strictly prohibited and can result in an investigation and/or the merging of relevant records.
- If you want to cancel your scores you should do so immediately after the test. Your request must be received by the fourth business day after a test administration. Once you submit your request to cancel scores, your scores cannot be reinstated and are not reported to you or your designated institutions.
- Only score reports from completed and scored tests are sent to your colleges and scholarship programs. Scores from future tests you registered for but haven't yet completed are not included. You can send all your scores to an institution, or you can choose which scores to send an institution by test date for the SAT and by individual test taken for SAT Subject Tests. Score Choice™ is optional, if you decide not to use it when
